This visually stunning glow-in-the-dark adventure has been praised for its cutting-edge blend of puppetry, technology, and dance by audiences all over the world. Dino-Light, formerly known as Darwin the Dinosaur, was the recipient of the prestigious Jim Henson Foundation Grant and the first feature-length theatrical production created and performed by creators Ian Carney and Corbin Popp.

There will be volunteers with flashlights in the outer aisles to assist patrons who may need to enter or exit the theater, but there will not be any lights in the audience, nor will there be any traditional stage lights.
